Community Relief Fund grants provided unrestricted operating support to local human service nonprofits and community groups meeting immediate, emergent, and unanticipated needs of people and communities impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

## Our Impact: By the Numbers

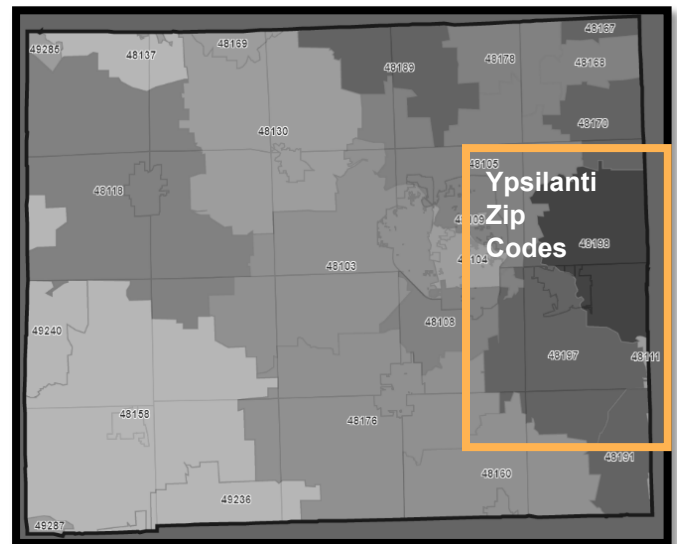
- **\$1,050,000:** Total awarded
- **78%:** Funding to Ypsilanti zip codes 48197/98
- **15%:** Funding to rural Washtenaw County
- **64:** # of grants awarded
- **75%:** Funding explicitly serving communities and people of color
- **39%:** Grants to agencies led by people of color

## Our Commitment to Equity

Prioritizing response efforts that attend to racial inequity remains a central tenet in United Way's grant making as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to reveal the disproportionate impact of this virus on people and communities of color.

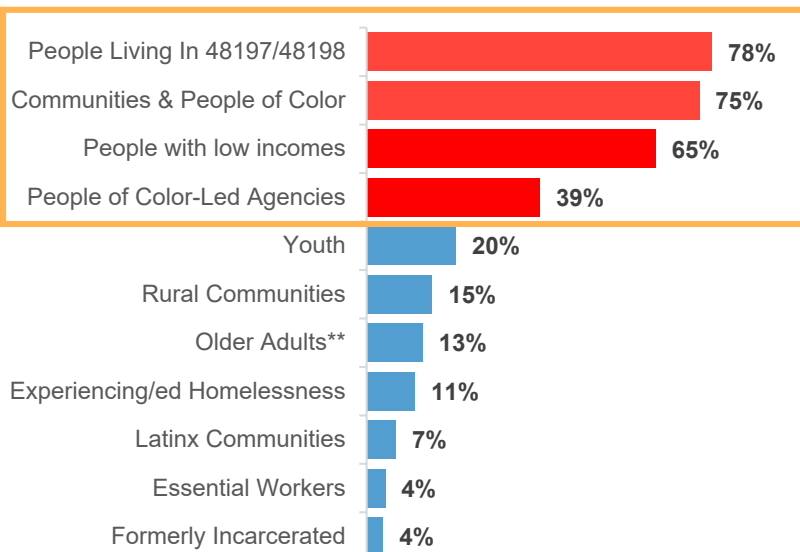

## COVID-19 Cases by Zip Code

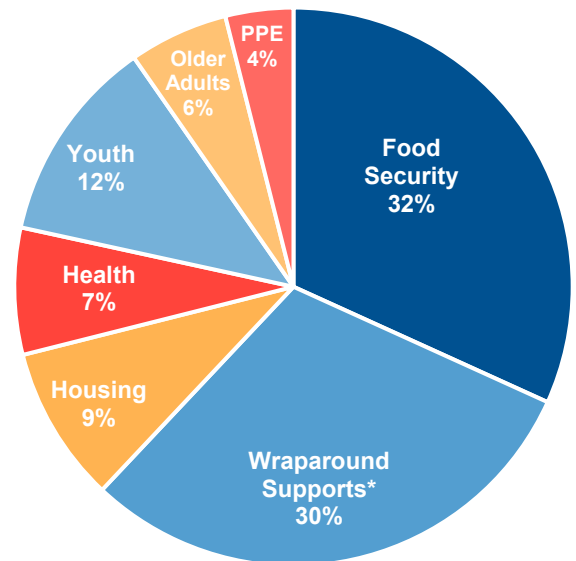
