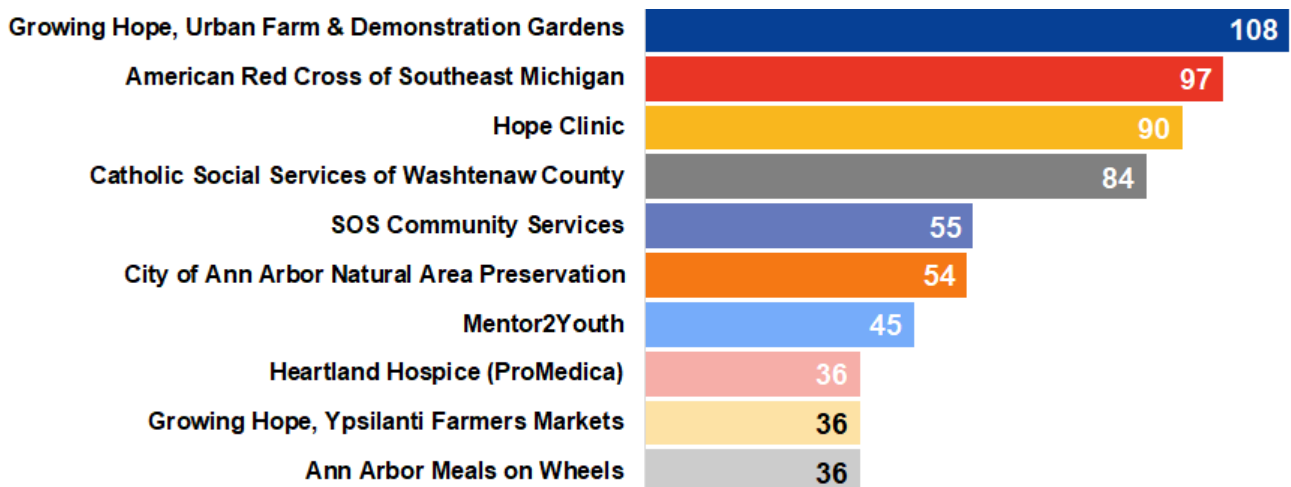

## CATCHAFIRE

Catchafire.org is an online skills-based volunteer platform which pairs pro bono professionals with nonprofits who need their skills to work on capacity building projects. The top three requested projects in Washtenaw County include website audits, logo design and visual brand identity, logo design. Michigan is supported through investments by the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation, the former Washtenaw Coordinated Funders, and the Michigan Health Endowment Fund. **With this capacity building opportunity for organizations, local nonprofits in Washtenaw County have saved more than \$975,000 this year.**
